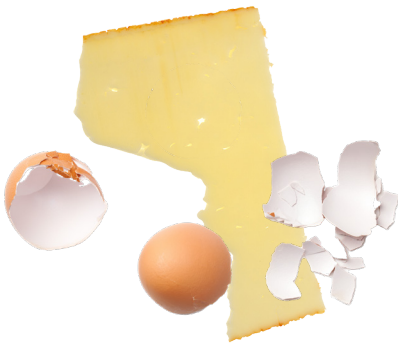
✓ All food waste

- ✓ Empty plastic bottles, containers and container lids (plastic bottle lids go in red bin)



- ✓ Cartons (not long-life)



- ✓ Aluminium and tin cans



- ✓ Glass bottles, jars and metal lids (empty and lids separated)



- ✗ No plastic bags
