

Competition summary

Glen Eira City Council is running a Golden Ticket competition for **Go for Gold 2023** (2-27 October). The competition aims to help registered schools to support their students to walk, ride, scoot or skate to school for the month of October. A student prize (one Fitbit Ace) per participating school and an interschool trophy are up for grabs. **Participating schools are required to run the Golden Ticket competition during October.**

How does the interschool competition work?

- Each student will receive a Golden Ticket at the start of term four (provided by Council, distributed by schools).
- Following each walk, ride, scoot or skate to school, the student, teacher or parent/guardian will tick a box on the student's Golden Ticket.
- At the end of the four weeks of Go for Gold, the student, teacher or their parent/guardian will ensure the Golden Ticket activities are documented on a classroom calendar, Council will provide to schools.
- Students must complete a minimum of 10 activities to or from school during 2-27 October to be eligible to enter the competition.
- Classroom calendars must be submitted to Council (either hardcopy or via email) between Friday 27 October and 5pm on Friday 3 November 2023
- Council will assess submitted calendars and determine the winner of the interschool Active Schools Trophy. The trophy will be awarded to the participating school that achieves the highest average activity rate per enrolled student. For example, a participating school with 300 enrolled students who collectively record 3000 activities on the Golden Ticket entries will achieve an average walking rate of 10 activities per student.
- The winning school will be determined by Council on Wednesday 22 November 2023, and the winner notified via email by Friday 24 November.
- Council will arrange a time and date with the winning school to present the trophy at a school assembly; it is hoped this will be at an assembly no later than Friday 1 December.

How does the student competition work?

• Council will provide each participating school with one Fitbit Ace. Schools will determine the recipient of the Fitbit via their discretion. This may be via an internal raffle or grounds of merit.

What do Glen Eira registered schools need to do to run the competition?

- Provide Golden Tickets and competition information to students (and parents/guardians) prior to and during the competition and encourage students to participate.
- Ensure Classroom Calendars are submitted to Council entries to be submitted between Friday 27 October and 5pm on Friday 3 November.

A student prize (one Fitbit Ace) per participating school and an interschool trophy are up for grabs. Participating schools are required to run the Golden Ticket competition during October.

How does the student competition work?

- Each student will receive a Golden Ticket at the start of term four (provided by Council, distributed by schools).
- Following each walk, ride or scoot to school, the student's parent/guardian will tick a box on the student's Golden Ticket.
- At the end of the four weeks of Go for Gold, the student or their parent/guardian will enter them into the competition by:
 - o completing the online entry form via www.gleneira.vic.gov.au/golden-ticket, or
 - submitting the Golden Ticket to the school office if hard copy Golden Tickets were provided to students.
- Students must complete a minimum of 10 activities to or from school during 3-28 October to be eligible to enter the competition.
- Entries must be submitted between Friday 28 October and 5pm on Friday 4 November 2022 to the school office (hard copy) or via www.gleneira.vic.gov.au/golden-ticket.
- Council will draw the student prize for each participating school on Monday 14 November and will notify each school of their student prize winner by Wednesday 16 November.
- Your school will notify its student prize winner in writing and present the student prize to the winner by no later than Friday 2 December.

How does the interschool competition work?

- Participating schools with students who submit their entries as listed above will automatically be in the running to win Council's Interschool Active Schools Trophy.
- The trophy will be awarded to the participating school that achieves the highest average
 activity rate per enrolled student. For example, a participating school with 300 enrolled
 students who collectively record 3000 activities on the Golden Ticket entries will achieve an
 average walking rate of 10 activities per student.
- The winning school will be determined by Council on Monday 14 November and the winner notified by email by Wednesday 16 November.
- Council will arrange a time and date with the winning school to present the trophy at a school assembly; it is hoped this will be at an assembly no later than Friday 2 December.

What do Glen Eira registered schools need to do to run the competition?
