### Statement of significance:

This large and healthy English Oak is located within a private garden that is covered by the existing Significant Landscape Overlay 1 within the Glen Eira Planning Scheme. It is located along the boundary with the historic Springthorpe Gardens which is the centrepiece of the original Omama Estate subdivision of 1909.

It is a particularly old and well-established example of the species within the municipality that makes a major contribution to the local landscape and neighbourhood character, especially in conjunction with other significant trees within the private property and neighbouring public gardens. It is an outstanding example of the species given its large size and health.
